CMA provides leadership trainings and equips local pastors and church leaders from least-reached, underdeveloped areas with knowledge and skills for effective ministry. The pastors are also provided with Bibles, and given mobility through bicycles and motorcycles.

## The Girls Rescue Center Highlights

It is so heart-warming to see so many girls given a lifeline to better their future by providing an education in a safe environment, away from abuse of genital mutilation and then married-off as child-brides to elderly men.

It is amazing to see the girls realize their potential to the highest levels of education and careers, with a key highlight being an aeronautical engineer with an international aircraft maker. The young girl was rescued from female genital mutilation and forced early marriage, excelled in school and is currently studying in the USA. CMA is so thankful for the support of dear partners like you who made the dream of this girl and many others like her to come true.

# Community Development

**Community Development Ministry:** CMA promotes community-driven approach that empowers leaders to use their God-given abilities to create sustainable development in their own communities to successfully overcome their needs and challenges.



**Orisai Irrigation project:** the drip irrigation system was implemented and onions planted on 5 acres, producing a bountiful harvest for consumption and for sale.

## **Sud Academy:** Upgrading the school's classrooms

Sud Academy has had a perennial problem of flooding, damaging the iron sheet classrooms and exposing the students to health hazards. Our partners built 7 spacious classrooms, offering a more conducive learning environment as well as making the school compliant to the Covid-19 protocols. The South Sudanese refugees and the local students from poor families now have a better opportunity to rebuild their lives by getting an education.

The feeding program at the school feeds 170 students everyday, providing a nutritious meal that is often the only meal that many students get for the day.

**Aid & Relief Ministry:** CMA provides quick and appropriate emergency relief and care to victims of natural and man-made disasters reaching many families that lack basic needs in Kenya and Uganda, and providing emergency medical and nutritional services in war-torn South Sudan. CMA is a leading organization in nutrition and medical interventions in South Sudan.



Over **4,500** needy families provided with nutritious food in **COVID-19** emergency relief

**19,649** Children under 5 years treated for malnutrition



**82,153** People reached with Primary Health Care

**13,049** primary caregivers received counseling

**519** adults received Covid-19 vaccination



**248** workers trained on community programs and management of common diseases

**32,195** Children received Vitamin A supplementation

**9,207** Pregnant and lactating women admitted and treated of malnutrition

**7,552** Mothers received Ante-Natal Care services

**870** Deliveries in the health facilities assisted by skilled birth attendants
