



Moral Code of Conduct

We honour God through our behaviour and in our relationships with others in true witness of the sacrifice Jesus Christ made for us all. Christian Mission Aid is a Christian organization, promoting the Christian faith (*Matthew 28:19 – 20*) in what work it does (*Matthew 25:35 - 36*) and how it does its work (*1 Corinthians 13:4 - 7; Ephesians 4:12; Acts 6:2 – 4*).

Therefore, we, the members of CMA accept strong Christian standards of moral conduct as written in scripture. In accepting strong Christian standards, we commit:

1. To live without malice or any evil intent; and to practice forgiveness, build understanding and seek harmony with associates, co-workers and family (*Matthew 6:14 - 15*);
2. To live and conduct our affairs with courtesy and respect for others; to decline participation in harassment, discriminatory and abusive activities; to be sympathetic, compassionate and humble; to be tolerant, patient and flexible in our work, social and family lives (*1 Peter 3:8 – 9; Titus 1:7 - 9*);
3. To practice moderation and self-control in our words, actions and lifestyles; and to refrain from behaviours forbidden in scriptures including the abuse of illegal substances (*1 Corinthians 5:11; 1 Thessalonians 4:3 – 6; Titus 2:1 - 8*);
4. To live and conduct ourselves with integrity based on honesty of word and action (*Luke 16:10; Colossians 3:9 – 10*);
5. To reserve sexual expressions of intimacy for marriage, a sacred covenant between one man and one woman, and to abstain from common law living situations (Mark 10:6-9; Heb. 13:4). We will refrain from the use of pornography and practice respectful modesty (Phil. 4:8; I Tim. 2:9-10).
6. And most importantly, to always strive to act with Christian love (*Luke 10:27*); to "practice" loving one another; and to put the needs and well-being of others first (*Luke 6:31 - 36; John 8:34 and 1 John 4:7 & 11*).
