through leadership training and equipped for effective ministry. Additionally, they receive Bibles and mobility tools such as bicycles and motorcycles to enhance their outreach effectiveness.

123 Pastors & Church leaders trained for works of service

515 Bibles & **77** Audio Bibles and **1,200** 4-Spiritual Laws distributed to pastors & churches

150 Pastors and JF stewards trained and **6 zones** in **Juba** mapped and about **60%** reached with Jesus Film shows

9,800 people reached with the Gospel of Jesus Christ through the **Jesus Film ministry** in **6** regions in **Juba, South Sudan**.

30 Pastors from Pokot and Marakwet had a follow-up training on Peace and Conflict Resolution. Committees of Peace-makers reported great progress in peace-building efforts..

23 Deaf Pastors trained and equipped for their special ministry to the deaf community.

This training equips them with the specialized tools, knowledge, and communication skills needed to lead, mentor, and shepherd the Deaf community.

A major challenge for pastors in rural areas is the difficulty of traveling long distances on foot in harsh terrain and hot sun. Addressing this need greatly enhances their ministries.

20 Motorcycles and **27** bicycles provided to rural pastors to enhance their ministry.

employs dynamic programs to mentor and empower young people, demonstrating Christ's love and preparing them to be influential leaders of their generation. By providing opportunities to pursue their dreams, CMA instills hope for a brighter future in these children's lives, unlocking their untapped potential.



The Girls' Rescue Center:

Dedicated to supporting survivors of FGM and early marriage, the Center provides a holistic recovery environment. The girls receive essential personal care, psychological counseling, and formal schooling.

71 girls presently residing at the Center

19 more girls were rescued this year

5 girls graduated from high school

20 girls getting a college education



Youth Camps & VBS:

423 children attended VBS and over **300** youths were mentored and trained in Youth camps.

Over **200** young people participated in Sports Outreach

God's Word Every Child (GWECC)

57 teachers trained and equipped to teach Bible stories to children in a fun and exciting way **5,510** booklets distributed to students & children attending Sunday school



Education Sponsorships:

109 students given the opportunity of an education in hope of a better future.

CMA and the SUNRAY Fund partner to bridge the education gap for South Sudanese refugee students seeking safety and a fresh start away from their war-torn homeland.

33 students were provided with primary, secondary and college education.



The SmartGirl/Boy Initiative:

Over **422** school girls provided with self-confidence, reproductive and hygiene education and given sanitary kits

345 boys mentored on peer pressure, drug abuse, health/hygiene, and relationships, all based on Christian principles

Ministry promotes a community-led strategy, empowering local leaders

Water filters distribution:

Over **2,000** families in Maasailand and urban slums now have immediate access to clean drinking water and protection from water-borne illness through CMA's proven dual approach of water filter distribution combined with hygiene and sanitation training-delivering life-changing impact to some of the most marginalized communities.



Adult Literacy Program:

Over **200** adults have attended **7** literacy classes, with transformative results for entire families. Maasai women in the program are now managing their business finances, reading their Bibles independently, and gaining newfound confidence. The women were also taught how to **make soap** for selling to earn some revenue. The visible impact on women's lives has been so compelling that more men have joined classes.

Widows ministry in Nyanza:

Ada's joyful smile (pictured right) tells the story of hundreds of widows living with HIV who have found hope through CMA's holistic support. By providing food, counseling, medical care, and education for their children, CMA ensures that vulnerable families like Ada's don't just survive - they thrive with dignity and renewed purpose.



School Desks Program:

CMA, together with Saruni International, delivered over **375** desks to Kajiado County schools, improving classroom comfort.



Aid & relief:

CMA delivers rapid, life-saving assistance to families devastated by disasters in Kenya and Uganda. In war-torn South Sudan, CMA's impact is profound, delivering vital nutrition and medical interventions that directly combat the devastating consequences of conflict and instability, saving lives and building resilience within vulnerable communities.



Thousands of struggling families in slums and hardship areas received life-saving emergency relief through CMA's **Food Buckets** program, which delivered essential, nutritious food to those most in need.
